

Arriving and departing in Lychen (nearby Berlin)

By Train

From Berlin central station (Hauptbahnhof) trains run every hour to Fürstenberg/Havel (travel time approximately 1 hour and 40 minutes).

Fürstenberg/Havel station – a bus runs every two hours to Schlüßhof/Lychen bus stop (bus number 517 drives through Zootzen, Bredereich, Himmelpfort, travel time approximately 20 minutes) (direction from Fürstenberg/ Havel to Templin)

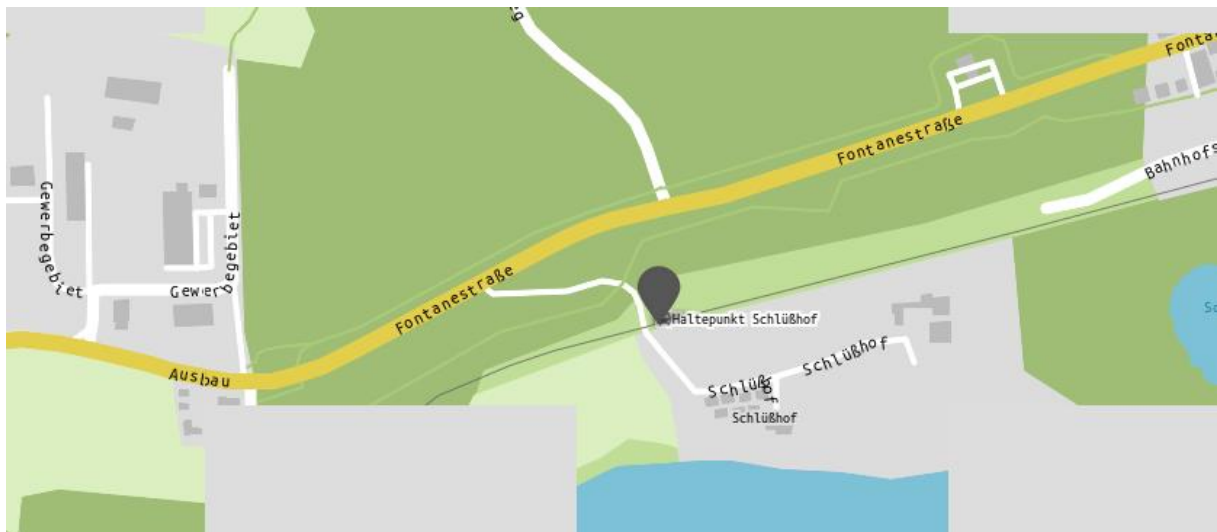
Train schedules

For **train** schedules and costs you may visit www.bahn.de/international/view/en/index.shtml. If booked well in advance special offers for long distance journeys can be obtained which can make travel on German trains quite cheap. Please try to arrive at **Fürstenberg/Havel** station, from where it will be easiest to arrange onward travel to Schlüßhof.

By Car

From the North of Berlin take the B96/Fürstenberg or the B109/Templin, Lychen.

Please note, if you take the B96: Schlüßhof is located BEFORE Lychen, directly at the bus stop Schlüßhof.
